

# How to Create a Facebook Watch Party




The Watch Party can be posted immediately or scheduled from the Creator Studio. A Watch Party can only be created from videos that have already been published to the Facebook page.

- 1. Click on Create Post.
- 2. Select Watch Party from the options of post type.
- 3. Select the video from the pop up list to "Add to Queue".






5. Schedule the day and time you want the Watch Party to begin in the newsfeed.



4. Write caption.



6. Click on Change Image to upload the image you want to show in the newsfeed with the caption. If you do not choose an image, it will publish using your current cover photo, which usually isn't relevant to the video itself.


