CREATING A NATIVE AMERICAN DWELLING: create a dwelling such as a Pueblo house, Navajo Hogan or Summer Shade Structure using skills in research, art, social studies, oral language and writing. Skills in historical and cultural relevance and importance of direction/sun in science. Some basic math skills

NATIVE AMERICAN VIEW OF THE CONSTELLATIONS: A science/reading/research/creative writing activity based on a Wasco Native American legend with emphasis on vocabulary and spelling as well as art and oral language. Skills learned will include relevance of the seasons, astronomy, navigation, storytelling, size, scale, estimation, creative writing and emotional connection to a unique story.

NATIVE AMERICAN LITERATURE: Biographical studies of three influential Native Americans (Shoshone, Nez Perce and Apache) in a variety of fields. This activity will stress skills in research/writing as well as reading, vocabulary, comprehension, cultural relevance, creative thinking and language arts skills.

CULTURAL ARTS ACTIVITY: A brief look at the Hopi culture using a reading and comprehension activity. Students will then create their own unique coiled clay bowl which will harden and can then be painted with traditional Hopi designs.

NATIVE AMERICAN DWELLING: Hogan/Pueblo Activity: craft sticks, glue, construction paper,

NATIVE AMERICAN SCIENCE: Constellation Activity: book, stars, black cardboard, colored chalk, 5 x 8 cards

NATIVE AMERICAN LITERATURE: Biography Activity: reading activity, writing paper, Tipi model, clay NATIVE AMERICAN ART: Hopi Cultural Activity: cardboard, clay, paints, brushes





