



The History Government Documents @ NMSL





Timeline of Events

- 1915 act passed "to regulate the management of the State Library" & "governed by a Board of Trustees"
- 1929 Legislature approves creation of the State Library Extension Service
- 1931 Library occupies new addition to the Palace of the Governors
- 1949 1963 library moved from place to place efforts for funding a new building began
- 1960 NMSL takes on added responsibilities as an FDLP Regional Library
- 1966 Library moved into location on Don Gaspar
- 1978 Legislation was passed which created a Depository Clearinghouse at the NMSL
- 1998 Library moves into current location on Camino Carlos Rey
- 2008 NMSL becomes a Selective Federal Depository
- 2016 NMSL, UNM, and NMSU became Shared Regional Libraries

How to start searching







When there is a known topic area but no known title

- Brainstorm what agency(ies) might have produced information Department of Health, Education, Fish & Wildlife, Local, National
- What kind of publication might that information be found
 Annual reports, congressional records, laws, environmental impact statements
- Begin your search at Govinfo.gov to search all branches of government
- Ask us here at NMSL for our thoughts

When there is a known title or agency


- Search agency website
