- Funded projects bring community groups to the Smithsonian Institution to work with collections pertaining to their language, traditional knowledge, or both
- Maximum grant is \$10,000 and covers travel, housing, meals, and incidentals in DC
- Diverse intergenerational groups encouraged: teachers, elders, artists, etc.
- All accessible Smithsonian repositories eligible for these research projects
