
The NM State Supreme Court Law Library is located inside the Supreme Court Building courthouse at 237 Don Gaspar Avenue in Santa Fe alongside the Santa Fe River on the corner of Don Gaspar and Alameda.

While there are some parking meter spaces near the building, most parking is reserved.

There is **free parking** available a block away from the building in a **public parking garage** across from the Roundhouse. The garage is located on the corner of Paseo de Peralta and Galisteo. The following link provides a map showing where the parking garage is located and a walking route from the garage to the <u>Supreme Court Building</u>.

When you arrive at the Court, please enter through the large, double brass doors at the front of the building. Disability parking and access is available at the South Entrance of the building on East De Vargas.

NOTE: You will **not be allowed** to bring any type of recording device, including cell phones.



The NM State Archives is located on the first/ground floor within the same building as the State Library at 1209 Camino Carlos Rey in Santa Fe.

Parking is free.
