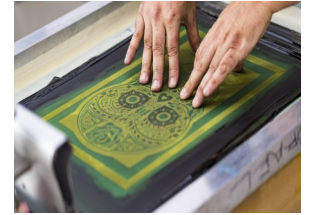

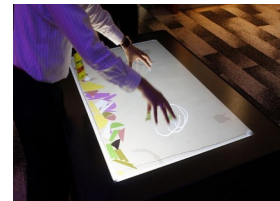
Programs
